

Safe cleaning liquid:

Supplies needed

2 GLASS JARS

32oz mason jars or re- purpose any large glass jar with a tight fitting lid

Spray bottle. (I got mine at the Dollar tree)

Citrus rinds; orange, lemon, limes or combination of these

White vinegar

Water. I've used tap water but you will see directions for distilled water too

1. Fill a mason jar with:
 - Citrus rinds
 - Cover with white vinegar
2. Seal the jar tightly and place in a dark cabinet for 2 weeks
Shake the jar periodically if you can remember to
3. Strain out the rinds putting the liquid in a second glass jar, discard the rinds in garbage disposal to keep that clean.
4. In your spray bottle
Depending on what you are using it for:
1part cleaner 3-4part water is typical
5. In a bucket:
 - 1 cup cleaner to 2 quarts water

If the surface becomes sticky or there is residue there was too much cleaner, wipe with a water wet towel.

I use this to clean the puppy pen, toys and their bowls

My counters, range top and sink. Refrigerator and trash can.

Recommended to check surface in a small area first.
